# TOHS Girls Soccer Commitment 2020-2021

Since its inception, the Conejo Valley Unified School District and TOHS has strived to offer the most comprehensive array of enrichment programs, athletics and extracurricular activities, particularly those deemed the most valuable by our community. Girls Soccer is pleased to offer a comprehensive and enriching educational experience to every participating student. State law requires us to provide a public education free of charge. Subject to certain exceptions, the right to a free public education means we cannot require students or their families to purchase materials, supplies, equipment or uniforms for any school activity, to pay security deposits for access, participation, materials, or equipment, or to make donations to a class, activity or program.

However, as it has been explained in other documents provided to you, Girls Soccer incurs expenses which are not covered by CVUSD. To pay for these important components of our program, we rely heavily on donations from parents and others, as well as various fundraising events. These donations directly benefit our students and make possible all of our planned activities and experiences — without this financial and logistical support from participating families we simply cannot maintain the quality program we want to continue to provide for our students. If we are unable to meet our fundraising goals, through both donations and fundraising events, it will be necessary to forego some of those activities and experiences.

Based on our planned activities and the projected costs of those activities, we are asking for a donation from each family. This requested donation is calculated by the cost of coaching stipends, training equipment, game equipment, t-shirts, uniforms, welcome meeting, banquet, senior night, website, banking, and office supplies. The requested donation is calculated at:

\$325 for Fr/So, \$350 for JV, and \$375 for Varsity.

This amount does not include the requested contribution for transportation.

Needless to say, we happily accept donations in excess of the requested amount!
